We have a thriving Community Association for Bellingdon and Asheridge. The biggest event of the year is the traditional village fete, held in June every year at the Village Hall. ### **Amenities**

As is typical of the so-called "hilltop villages" to the north of Chesham, the villages are linear, and rural in character. The villages benefit from a village hall which is used for several community groups during the week as well as being available to the public for hire. It has a large recreation ground as well as an adventure playground. bellingdon.com/village-hall/

St John's Church, in the centre of Bellingdon, is part of the parish of Great Chesham. The current tin tabernacle was built in 1901. There is a service each Sunday at 10:00, a monthly 'Knit and Natter' group, and a three-monthly History and Culture Club. Further information is on the village website.

The local **primary school** is Hawridge & Cholesbury Church of England School and is situated in Hawridge.

Bellingdon and Asheridge are in the catchment area for Chiltern Hills Academy and Chesham Grammar School in Chesham, Dr. Challoner's Grammar School for boys in Amersham and Dr. Challoner's High School for girls in Little Chalfont.
